Orthotic services provide care most frequently for those with functional lower limb problems, where the provision of an orthosis will reduce pain, improve walking or increase stability. The types of conditions seen frequently include; osteo arthritis, stroke, neuropathic feet, joint pain, polio and cerebral palsy.

The types of orthoses can include; insoles, footwear, ankle-foot orthoses, callipers and spinal orthoses. These can be pre-made orthoses that can be supplied on the day of the appointment or manufactured specifically to the needs of individual patients.
