Steady...”

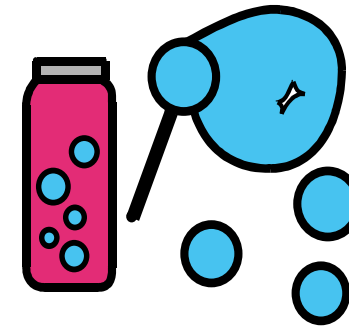
Your child says...

We can **sing** about bubbles!

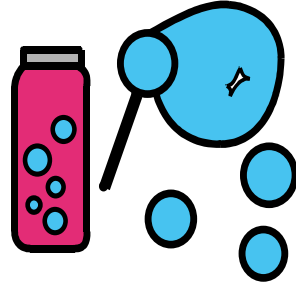

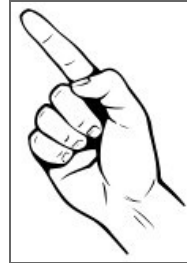
