



TAP@The Whittington Hospital 2019/20

The Autism Project (TAP) has been running at The Whittington Hospital for almost 12 months and we have already had some great outcome. 100% of our students that attended TAP@ The Whittington have successfully moved on. Two have found employment within the NHS, one has secured a place at university and one is starting an apprenticeship with TFL in September.

Facts and benefits

- We have students ready to start in Late September/ October, no additional recruitment needed.
- No staff recruitment needed by the departments.
- ➤ Low levels of resources needed.-TAP staff based at the Whittington would provide support for staff.
- TAP is an established and proven project. It has been running at GSTT since 2010.
- > TAP has supported over 85 young people over the last 9 years.
- Currently 8 past students work at GSTT, two students have been working there for 8 years.
- > Staff at the Whittington would gain autism awareness training and ongoing support to make reasonable adjustments to support the students.
- Meets Disability Confidence standards
- > Students could move onto apprenticeships and support the trust to meet their targets within the apprenticeship levy.
- Opportunities for staff to meet CPD targets via the support they give our students.
- Programme runs for 3-4 days a week (1 day will be class-room based, where functional skills and employability are covered, this will be off site)
- A CareTrade staff member is always on site when students are on placements.
- Students will attend one rotation per term within the hospital and may also be able to attend 'taster' sessions in other department if they are available
