Most are free, or low cost. You can also meet other local parents and parents-to-be in friendly, safe and welcoming venues across the borough.

### Where can I find Bright Start Islington?

You can find Bright Start services and activities in our 16 children's centres, as well as health centres, libraries and community centres. Some services, such as health visiting and family support, are offered in your home.

You can pop into your local children's centre and fill in a registration form or download a form from **www.islington.gov.uk/brightstart**Once you're registered you can use any children's centre or other local venue where Bright Start activities and services are being provided.

# Pregnancy to age 1: the first 21 months

There are lots of fun activities to help mums and dads bond with their babies, such as baby massage, toy libraries and baby bounce, provided in safe and welcoming venues. Health visiting, breastfeeding and family support, and midwife visits are offered at your home, while health clinics and children's centres offer antenatal appointments, immunisations and free vitamins.

# Age 1-3: the toddler years

Toddlers need lots of opportunities to play and explore as they become more independent and develop their skills. Friendship and support networks help parents to manage the daily challenges of caring for toddlers. Bright Start Islington provides high quality activities during these years. Parents may want to start thinking about preparing for work, and we can help with this too.

## Age 3-5: nursery and beyond

Through Bright Start Islington, all children receive high quality early education which supports their development and helps them to prepare for school. Parents also have the chance to continue on their path towards employment, thinking about options for work, volunteering, training or study.



### **Our support**



Early education and childcare, including nurseries and childminders.



Child and family health including midwifery, health visiting and speech and language support.



Breastfeeding support, infant feeding and healthy eating.



Stay and play and other activities for you and your child to enjoy and learn together, such as storytelling, singing and music. These sessions are a great opportunity to meet other parents and children and make lasting friendships.



Family and parenting support. This includes parenting programmes and free and confidential one-to-one support and advice on issues such as sleep, behaviour, establishing routines, as well as a range of parenting programmes.



Employment, training, benefits and money advice, English and computer classes.



Services for children with special educational needs (SEN) and disabilities.
