Once complete, CRN NT/Noclor will request approval from the relevant ICSU Clinical Director and once approved by CD (& if needed, contract signed) C&C is issued

Once the Sponsor has received the confirmation of C&C email from CRN/Noclor and all required documents they will issue a greenlight email – the study can then officially begin
