Does your trust/ HB have access to PET-CT for the investigation of suspected biochemical recurrence in prostate cancer patients?

If so, what are they? E.g. Upper and lower PSA limits, age, life expectancy, ECOG score. No formal criteria exist.

Request 7:

What do you estimate is the average waiting time for the PET-CT scans for investigation of suspected biochemical recurrence of prostate cancer?

Approximately 2 weeks

What do you estimate is the average time it takes to report PET-CT scans for investigation of suspected biochemical recurrence of prostate cancer? Available within 48hours of scan.
