Tip sheet – The Toilet Area

Making the area safe:

- Stay nearby when your child is sitting on the toilet
- Use the right equipment for your child's needs such as a toilet seat inset to make the toilet hole smaller, a padded toilet seat for comfort or a footstool
- Make sure the toilet is not too noisy
- Make sure the toilet is not too hot or too cold



Make the area relaxing:

- Play music which makes them relax or feel happy
- Choose a toilet paper your child likes
- Use soap, room sprays and disinfectants your child likes (not too strong)



Use a toilet toy:

- The toilet toy is to encourage your child to stay sitting on the toilet
- You can only play with it when sitting on the toilet
- Check that the toilet toy remains motivating; you may need to change it for something else! Some children have a few toys or books that are rotated every couple of days.



Possible reasons that children may refuse to go into the toilet area:

- Noise from the toilet flush, fan, hand dryers Turn these off when your child is in the toilet
- Glare from bright lights Use soft lighting or a coloured light shade
- Cold toilet seat You can get toilet seat covers
