

FoI request re: Admissions of <18 patients with mental health disorder Ref: 23-RT-3103

Thank you for your request for information relating to the number of patients under 18 admitted with a diagnosis of mental health disorder.

Please find our responses below:

Request 1:

Please provide me with the following data for the years: 2019, 2020, 2021,2022, 2023 (to date):

The total number of under-18s admitted with a primary diagnosis of mental health disorder to a paediatric bed

Caveats:

- The data is based on patients with an admission date from 01/01/2019 present.
- It only includes discharged patients who have been coded on our system.
- It only includes diagnoses below (eating disorders have been identified as F50, everything else as mental health)
- This is a count of admissions, not patients, so some patients have been counted more than once if they have had >1 admission.

This exempts personal data if disclosure would contravene any of the data protection principles contained in the GDPR 2018.
