How can I help my child with a hearing impairment?



- If needed, get the child's **attention** by patting their shoulder
- Be **face-to-face** when talking together so they can see the way your mouth makes the sounds
- Use **gestures** and **facial expressions** to help their understanding
- Remove any **background noise** (e.g. turning off TV or washing machine)
