



## **Can you help us find out more about chronic urinary tract infections?**

We are looking for post-menopausal women to participate in a research study investigating the links between the vaginal microbiome and urinary tract infections (UTI)



### **Who is running the study?**

- A team of doctors, nurses and researchers specialising in UTI. The clinic is based at The Whittington Hospital and the research is lead by University College London

### **Who is invited to participate?**

- Post-menopausal women, aged 40 and above, with frequent or persistent (chronic) UTIs
- Post-menopausal women with no symptoms but who would like to volunteer as a healthy 'control' participant

### **What will it involve?**

- Samples of urine and swabs from the vagina will be taken at four appointments, 3 months apart for all participants
- If you suffer with UTI, you will receive specialist UTI treatment alongside this
