How can I help my little one learn to talk?



- Show **you are interested in the same thing** - Look at it, point to it, and name it (e.g. **“Car!” “Dog!” “Big ball!”**)
- Get **down to their level** - Let them see your face
- **Give your child time** to communicate - They may use sounds, pointing, or look at you
- Play **with sounds together** - Copy their sounds and add new ones (e.g. **“moo!” “beep beep!” “splash!”**)
