Whittington Health provide clinical placements for Middlesex student midwives. They are offered full support throughout their training from a full-time Clinical Practice Facilitator and mentors in every area of work. There is also a student support midwife who works clinically alongside students. Clinical Skills training is available on site including; Suturing, Obstetric Emergencies', Fetal Monitoring, Supporting Vulnerable adults and Bereavement. Link Lecturers from Middlesex University are on site at the Hospital once a week to support students and staff.
