Refer to Medical Registrar via switchboard (out of hours) bleep 3300

Consider Ambulatory Care for patients with a problem that cannot be managed in General Practice or outpatients, but who are likely to be discharged eg. possible DVT, PE, cellulitis, low risk pneumonia, pyelonephritis, renal colic etc Access to the Frailty team via Ambulatory Care for urgent geriatric assessment



PAEDIATRICS

SURGERY

Refer to Surgical Registrar via switchboard bleep 3376 who will advise if Ambulatory Care is an appropriate alternative Children under 6 should be referred to paediatrics instead

UROLOGY

Refer to Urology Registrar via switchboard



GYNAECOLOGY

Refer to Gynae Registrar via switchboard bleep 3040 who will advise whether to send to Women's Diagnostic Unit (currently no walk-ins) or to the Emergency Department for Gynae review

OBSTETRICS

Send to Labour Ward triage (020 7288 5880) if over 18 weeks, otherwise refer to Gynae Registrar as above Non-obstetric emergencies dealt with in normal pathways

Please call the relevant specialty to determine where the patient should attend based on the clinical scenario.

In an emergency, please contact the specialty team once the patient is safely on route to hospital.

If you cannot get through, please include the following in the letter:

- Which specialty should see this patient?
- Are they likely to require admission?
- What do they need?

Injuries can be sent to the Emergency Department 24hrs a day

for possible fractures (in hours) send to Level 3 Imaging with an x-ray form or email the form to whh-tr.imagingappointments-whitthealth@nhs.net Images will be reviewed immediately and patients with fractures sent to ED
